Consulting Services for Developing Environmental Impact Assessments for the construction or extension of 12 sewerage systems and of 5 waste water treatment plants

Romania has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) and a Grant from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) to support the implementation of the Integrated Nutrient Pollution Control (the Project) in selected localities vulnerable or potentially vulnerable to the pollution with nutrients (NVZs). The overall development objective of the project is to support the Government of Romania to meet the EU Nitrates Directive requirements by (a) reducing nutrients discharges to water bodies, (b) promoting behavioral changes at the communal level, and (c) strengthening institutional and regulatory capacity. The ultimate goal is to reduce over the long-term the discharge of nutrients and other agricultural pollutants into the Danube River and Black Sea through integrated land and water management.

The purpose of the assignment is to carry out environmental impacts (EIAs) assessment for the construction or extension of 12 sewerage systems and of 5 waste water treatment plants in a number of 12 localities selected from the localities identified as nitrates vulnerable/potentially vulnerable zones (NVZs)

The EIAs should be done for each investment in accordance with Romanian and World Bank's environmental policies and relevant international environmental agreements/conventions to which the country is a part.

The consultancy assignment is anticipated to be carried out over a period of maximum 6 calendar months from the contract signing. It is estimated that the assignment will involve a total effort of some 65 man-days.

The assignment will be carried out by an individual consultant (working under the Law no. 300/2004 regarding the authorization of individual persons and family associations to carry out independent activities) with expertise of at least 5 (five) years in the development of EIA studies. The consultant must be registered within The National Registry of Developers of Environmental Studies of the Romanian Ministry of Environment and Forests established according to MO 1026/2009.

The consultant shall :

- a) have previous experience in EIA development related to World Bank or EU funded projects (assignments carried out in EU member states and/or CEE countries is considered a plus);
- b) prove direct experience of at least 2 similar projects successfully completed;

c) good knowledge of English language ;

The Ministry of Environment and Forestry now invites eligible Individual Consultants to send their Curriculum Vitae for providing consulting services for developing EIA studies for 12 sewage construction works and 5 waste water treatment plants.

The CVs must provide information indicating that the Consultant is qualified to perform the assignment, respectively:

- General information: duration of professional activity, background level of education and training, positions held, level of responsibility, etc.
- Specific information on the Consultant's experience in the developing EIA studies
- Information on the Consultant's experience in region with World Bank or EU funded projects (assignments carried out in EU member states and/or CEE countries).

The Consultant will be selected using SIC (Selection of Individual Consultants), in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's [*Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers*](#), May 2004.
