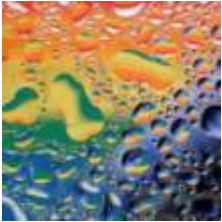

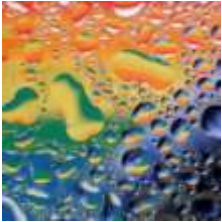

Project Objectives

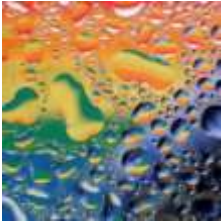

Main tasks



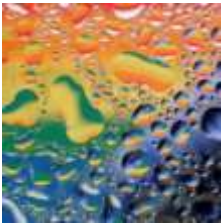
- Organise workshops in 5 selected countries (first year focus on EU-12)
